And nothing else. It's simple but practical. (You can stick a small clipart in it, if you feel the urge. Snowflakes for January, whatever.) Then you have the slicker, polite option of Microsoft Office Online. This is the prefab calendar for different applications and purposes. 64 of them, absolutely. There are a variety of academic calendars in Visio, Excel, Publisher, and Word formats. Calendars by month, year, and years. Portraits, landscapes, five days, seven. A variety of extremely ugly PowerPoint calendars, including some false stripes and a kind of Madras plaid. Lunar calendars for different time zones (those who know the moon works that way), photo calendars, postcard calendars. And even a basic 12-month calendar in Word without a single scrap of pointless art decoration design on it. If your interests run that way. Happy calendar!
